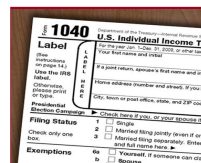

2. CANNED FOOD—all sorts...vegetables, fruits, soups, meats, etc.
3. STAPLE ITEMS—dry beans, rice, pasta, hamburger helper, peanut butter, flour, sugar, sweet & low, coffee, tea, spices, salt, pepper, etc.
4. PAPER GOODS—toilet tissue, paper towels, wax paper, aluminum foil, sandwich bags, napkins, paper plates, etc.
5. PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS—shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, tooth brushes, shaving cream, hairspray, etc medical supplies, etc.
6. CLEANING SUPPLIES—laundry detergent, bleach, dish detergent, brillo pads, spic-n-span, window cleaner, bathroom cleaner, furniture polish, etc.
